

Networking Corner via Wonder

For all interested participants we offer a “Networking Corner”, in which you can get in touch with other participants in individual or group discussions. Clicking on the green button opens a new tab and you will be redirected to the networking platform “Wonder”. In order for other participants to hear and see you, you must first allow access to your microphone and camera. After entering your name and taking a photo, you will be able to virtually move around the room. You will see all the other participants who are currently in the networking corner and who is talking to whom. To start or join a conversation, simply drag your avatar close to another person or to an existing circle. It is possible to set a conversation to "private" so that no other participant can join in.

The green sign shows you whether the booth staff of the exhibitor is currently online. Clicking on a booth or the corresponding logo takes you directly to the virtual booth.
